Asia Dinosaur Association Constitution

ARTICLE 1 NAME

This Association shall be known as "Asia Dinosaur Association" (ADA).

ARTICLE 2 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Association shall be to: promote research of paleontology and geology related to Asian dinosaurs; advance dinosaur research and educate general public; support and encourage students and young researchers; develop the culture of dinosaurs.

ARTICLE 3 ACTIVITIES

- 1 In order to achieve the purposes mentioned in the article 2,
- (1) As a general rule, the Association shall hold an biyearly meeting;
- (2) Progressing, promotion and encouragement of dinosaur research;
- (3) Publication, popularization and inform advancement in dinosaur research;
- (4) Technological guidance and training of dinosaur research;
- (5) Education, popularization and enlightenment of dinosaur;
- (6) Exchange and cooperation with the related associations and organizations;
- (7) And the other activities carried out through to achieve the purposes of the Association.

ARTICLE 4 GOVERNANCE

- 1 The Honorary President, President, and Vice-Presidents are elected from among the members of the Board of Directors;
- 2 The administration of the President and Vice-Presidents serves 4 years;
- 3 The Secretary general are elected from the compatriot of the President;
- 4 The Vice-Presidents are elected from the membered countries;
- 5 The membered countries can recommend Vice-Secretary generals (maximum 2 persons), and the administration serves 4 years;
- 6 The ADA Office is settled in Fukui Prefectural Dinosaur Museum (FPDM). An Executive Secretary general of the agency shall be selected from the staff of FPDM.

ARTICLE 5 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 1 The Board of Directors consists of the Honorary President(s), President, Vice-Presidents, Executive Secretary general and Secretary general;
- The governance of this Association are vested in the Board of Directors. But slight subjects are entrusting to the ADA Office;
- 3 The Board of Directors may vote and transact its business by mail, telephone, electronic communication, or other appropriate communications technology, coordinated through the Executive Secretary general of the ADA Office.

ARTICLE 6 TREASURER

- 1 The chief accounting officer is the Executive Secretary general;
- 2 Two auditors are appointed in the ADA Office;
- 3 Except quite important subjects, the expenditure is entrusting to the ADA Office.

ARTICLE 7 MEMBERSHIP

ARTICLE 8 AMENDMENTS

Articles of this Constitution may be amended by approval from a one-half (1/2) plus one majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors.

Supplementary provision

This Constitution takes effect from 12th July, 2013.
