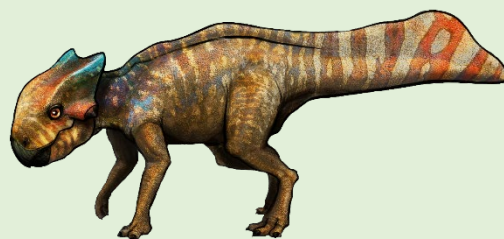
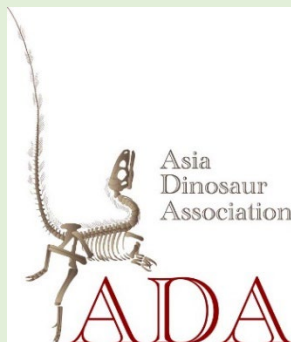

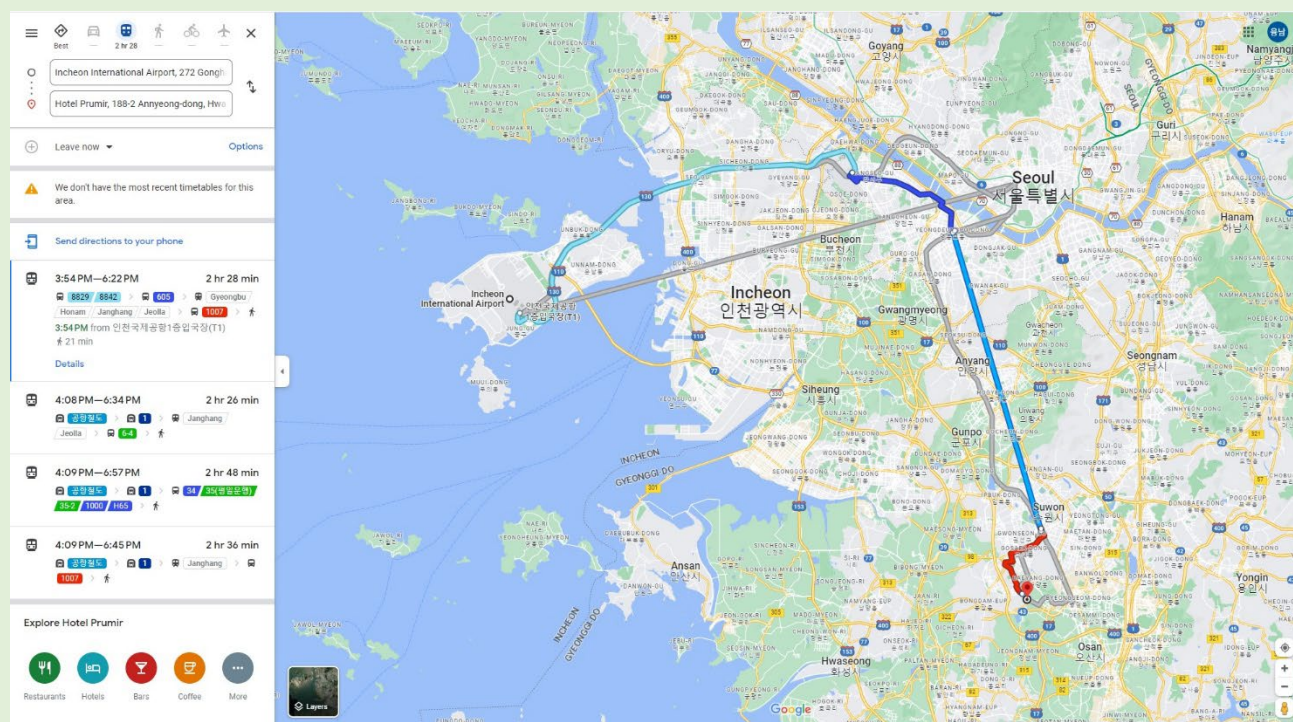


8. TRAVEL INFORMATION

- Three ways from Incheon International Airport to Prumir Hotel.
 1. **Bus:** You can take the bus (4100) from Incheon Int'l Airport Terminal 1 or 2 to Suwon Station; then take a taxi to Prumir Hotel.
 2. **Subway:** even though there is a way, We do not recommend it. It takes more time than the bus due to detouring (see the map below).

3. **Taxi:** You can take a taxi from Incheon International Airport directly to Prumir Hotel.

*** The Prumir Hotel is located far from the big towns. Although there are a few public transportations, it would be complicated for foreigners to use them (options 1 and 2 above). So, **We recommend taking a taxi, which is the best way to get to the hotel without getting lost.** It would cost approximately US\$ 80 (It takes 1 hour and 10 minutes if there is no traffic jam).



9. ACCOMMODATION

“**Hotel Prumir**” is a 4-star Hotel between the University of Suwon, Yungneung, and Geolleung Royal Tombs (see below). We will have the symposium as well as accommodation in this hotel. Because there is no motel or hotel nearby, we do not have any other option except to stay in **Hotel Prumir**. Fortunately, we negotiated with the hotel and breakfast for a discount for all symposium participants. **We will reserve the room for registered participants.**

Price: Superior(SUD, double) 80,000 KRW (= 61.5 USD)

Deluxe(DXT twin): 80,000 KRW (= 61.5 USD)

Breakfast: 16,000 KRW (= 12.3 USD)

* Fitness room and high-speed internet are provided in the room price. Breakfast is **NOT** included,

All rate includes VAT 10%. As of 2023/06/15, 1 USD= 1,300 KRW(Korean Won)

12. PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Oral Presentation

All presentations must be written and presented in English. Each presentation should take 20 minutes (15 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for questions and answers).

A computer will be provided for an oral presentation. All speakers must bring presentation files (PowerPoint format) and give them to the staff before the presentation starts according to a schedule.

Poster Presentation

All posters must be written and presented in English. The size of the poster should be 90 cm wide and 120 cm high. The content should be clear and understandable.

Poster presentation: Recording oral presentations is prohibited, except for the first author. Please feel free to contact us for further information at isad2023korea@gmail.com

13. ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

All abstracts must be written in English and using Times New Roman font.

Title: font-size: 14 pt, bold, capitalize the first letter of each word except prepositions, articles, and species names (Italicize scientific names of taxa).

Author's names: font-size: 12 pt, not bold, and order of names displays as a first name and then last name (e.g., Rinchen Barsbold).

Affiliations: font-size: 10 pt, put after the number of order address and follow with an e-mail address (e.g., Institute of Paleontology and Geology, Mongolian Academy of Sciences, S. Danzan Street-3/1, Ulaanbaatar-15160, Mongolia).

**Corresponding author*: use the asterisk (*) after the number of order address and e-mail address (e.g., isad2023korea@gmail.com).

Abstract: font-size: 12 pt.

Keywords: font-size: 12 pt, and not more than five words.

References: not allowed

Words must not exceed 5,000 characters (word counting including title, authors, affiliations, space, and punctuation).

Figures and tables are **NOT** acceptable.

Abstracts will be published in an abstract volume distributed during the symposium. Please submit your abstract by **September 15, 2023.**

Abstract submitting procedure:

1. Name of your file (*.doc or *.docx) as "last name of the first author-type of presentation" (e.g., "Owen_oral.docx; Owen_poster.docx").
2. Please submit your abstract to isad2023korea@gmail.com. Once the abstract is received, you will receive a confirmation e-mail. Notification regarding accepting or rejecting abstracts will be sent within 20 days.

14. REGISTRATION FEES AND PAYMENT

Registration fee includes a symposium kit, coffee breaks, welcome dinner (November 8), banquet (November 9), and access to all scientific sessions. Please note that the registration fee does **NOT** include accommodation, insurance coverage, and the post-symposium excursion. **Information on the registration and payment will be announced through the 3rd Circular on July 15. 18. CLIMATE IN KOREA

The weather in Hwaseong around early November is typical autumn season. The temperature would be between 9°C and 11°C but may exceed a temperature unexpectedly.

The average rainfall is 9.0 mm. All participants are recommended to bring necessary personnel such as a sun hat, sunblocks, good daily changeable clothes (hot day and cold day), medicines (if you have one), good hiking boots, and others.
