

The 6th International Symposium on Asian Dinosaurs in Japan 2025

Guideline for the ADA Student Grant

1. Summary and Purpose

Asia Dinosaur Association (ADA) is offering a financial support for traveling and lodging for the 6th International Symposium on Asian Dinosaurs in Japan 2025 (ISAD2025) to be held from September 26th to 30th, 2025 in Fukui, Japan. The grant is designed for students who intend to present their studies at ISAD2025. The purpose of this support is to encourage young researchers to lead future studies on Asian dinosaurs and related fields.

2. Qualification

- I. Those who belong to colleges, universities, graduate schools or other educational institutes without being permanently employed.
- II. Those who are registered for oral/poster presentations for ISAD2025.
- III. Those who do not have financial support to participate in ISAD2025 from other societies, organizations, institutes or universities.

3. Application

- I. Download, fill, and submit the application form on the ISAD2025 website (<https://dinoasia.asia/>).
- II. One recommendation letter may be uploaded with the application form.
- III. The deadline is **July 1st, 2025**.

4. Recipient Screening

- I. A committee assigned by ADA Secretary Office will screen recipients based on submitted applications.
- II. Applicants will be contacted for the results of the screening (accepted or not accepted) by July 15th, 2025.

5. Grant

- I. The maximum amount of the grant is 100,000 JPY for each recipient.
- II. The amount of the grant will be calculated based on applications.
- III. The grant will be provided at the reception of ISAD2025.
- IV. The grant will be made in JPY.

V. The grant will not be provided if its recipient is absent during ISAD2025.

VI. The grant cannot be provided preceding or following ISAD2025.

6. Notes

- I. The recipient will be asked to provide her/his signature when receiving the grant.
- II. Application form will not be returned to the applicant regardless of the result of the screening.
- III. Applicant's personal information will only be used to implement this support. The information may be provided to universities, research institutions, diplomatic missions, government offices, or non-profit organizations as necessary, and will not be used for any other purposes.
